

RESTRICTED MEDICATIONS THAT WILL NOT BE REFILLED VIA E-VISIT

This excluded medication list consists of, but is not limited to the following:

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

- Schedule II: Oxycodone (OxyContin), Hydrocodone (Vicodin), Methamphetamine, Fentanyl, Cocaine, Adderall, Vyvanse, methylphenidate, Lisdexamfetamine, Dexamfetamine, Atomoxetine, guanfacine,
- Schedule III: Buprenorphine (Suboxone), Ketamine, Anabolic steroids, Some combination products with codeine.
- Schedule IV: Alprazolam (Xanax), Clonazepam (Klonopin), Diazepam (Valium), Lorazepam (Ativan), Zolpidem (Ambien).
- Schedule V: Lacosamide, Pregabalin, Some combination products with codeine.

Benzodiazepines

- alprazolam (Xanax®), chlordiazepoxide (Librium®), clorazepate (Tranxene®), diazepam (Valium®), halazepam (Paxipam®), lorazepam (Ativan®), oxazepam (Serax®), prazepam (Centrax®), and quazepam (Doral®). Clonazepam (Klonopin®), diazepam, and clorazepate are also used as anticonvulsants.
